4th Easter of Sunday: April 21, 2024 (Good Shepherd Sunday)

See what love the Father has given us, that we should be called children of God. (1Jn 3.1) Have you ever deeply pondered on the fact that you are a child of God? If we allow it, this mystery can ignite a mystical journey from this moment forward. Letting the reality of our true identity settle into our hearts is a magnificent grace - one that can free and empower us. It can remind us that God doesn't make junk - and that, as his children, we are precious. Nestling into the relationship as a child of his, we'll be called to snuggle up to him listen to him, praise him, thank him, take refuge in him, rejoice in him, run to him for help.
